It takes great courage to disclose abuse and a high level of trust. We would hope that any person who comes forward to say that they were abused would experience a compassionate and helpful response from the staff of the safeguarding office.

## DECIDING WHETHER TO CONTACT THE JESUIT SAFEGUARDING OFFICE

- The office is staffed with lay professionals who are experienced in talking with people who have had traumatic experiences.
- You are welcome to contact by letter, by email or by phone.
- Sometimes people want to meet. We will meet you when you are ready and share information with you on the supports available.
- Sometimes people want to share with us their experiences of harm. This is done entirely at the pace that is right for the individual who was harmed.
- Often a person who was abused has questions about what happened and how. The staff of the safeguarding office will do their best to answer questions.
- Counselling is provided by external services free of charge to the person using the service. Find information on this under "Useful Contacts".

- The Jesuits have in place a redress scheme for persons who were sexually abused as children by a Jesuit. <u>Link to Jesuit Redress Scheme</u>
- If a report needs to be made to An Garda Síochána and Tusla – the Child & Family Agency, we will explain this to you.
